## - Title -

“Zoonoses / One Health in the context of the global health centres - more than 3 overlapping circles”.

## - Abstract -

One Health is defined as a collaborative, multisectoral approach working locally, nationally, or globally to achieve optimal health outcomes. It plays a big role to prevent zoonotic diseases, which are more than 75 % of diseases known to humans. Part of the one health concept involves professionals of human and animal health, environment and other areas like law enforcement, politics, agriculture, sociology, community science and energy. No sector can address issues at this interface alone. In the context of the health centres, the concept of one health is a common denominator. We will discuss and identify synergies covering animal, human and environmental health, and address the prevention and surveillance of zoonoses within the Centers’ global regions.

## - Agenda –

The workshop will consist of a presentation session followed by a panel discussion. The presentations will take place from 14:00 p.m. to 14:40 p.m. - each health centre will present the current situation of regional zoonotic diseases in their respective area. This will be followed by a panel discussion from 14:40 p.m. to 15:10 p.m. to create global synergies within the One Health concept. The workshop will end with a concluding remark of 5 minutes.
